Facilities Update

The number of emergencies has slowed over the last few months – we are thankful. There continues to be a list of small clean up items that we are continuing to work on as we move into the Advent season.

The request for a credit from the LADWP, regarding the two major water leaks we had this summer, has been re-submitted. We have an appointment to meet with them, on campus, in late November.

We were glad to see some rain in mid-November. It gives our landscaping a chance to enjoy a good watering and at the same time saves on our own water bill.

We had the solar array checked out in early November. We suspected one of the inverters was not working which seemed to be the case. With a simple reset it was up and running again. If anyone has an interest in overseeing the solar array, please contact the church office. We need someone to monitor what electricity is produced and oversee any regular maintenance or cleaning that is required. Not a lot of time required – just an interest in making sure we continue to make the most out of our solar system!

Advent Project

Hope the Mission Family Shelter The Woodlands on Ventura Blvd.

Between December 3 and 17, we will be collecting money and gift cards as our Advent Project.

Hope the Mission's family shelter, opened in May, 2023 with 100 units, housing up to 400 people. Each room comes with four bunk beds, a microwave, mini-fridge and bathroom. Residents are provided three meals per day as well as mental health services if needed. Currently there are 275 children in residence, most of whom are in school.



Laura Longman Memorial Scholarship 2024 Applications Available Sunday December Third



The Laura Longman Memorial Scholarship Committee begins its 40th season by announcing the availability of applications for scholarship grants to students who will be a junior or senior in college in the

Fall of 2024. At least one \$1000 scholarship grant will be given on Easter Sunday, March 31, 2024. Applications are available beginning Sunday, December 3, 2023 from the First United Methodist Church office. Completed applications must be returned to the church office by Thursday, February 15, 2024 to be considered.

The Laura Longman Memorial Scholarship is given in loving memory of Laura Lynn Longman (1958 – 1984) who grew up in First United Methodist Church of Canoga Park. Laura was a vital member of our youth group, served as liturgist, sang in the choir, taught Sunday school and was well known by most members of the church. As a young adult she contracted heart disease and eventually underwent an experimental heart transplant. She was the 176th successful heart-transplant patient at Stanford University Medical Center. She returned to the life she loved as a college junior majoring in Biochemistry at San Francisco State University. It was there, in her classroom that Laura died at the age of 25. Laura's family and friends in the First United Methodist Church founded the Laura Longman Memorial Scholarship as a living memorial to celebrate her life and her love of learning. Laura died before she could finish her college education. This scholarship is designed to help other students finish their undergraduate studies. The first scholarship grants were given on Easter Sunday, 1985. In the 39 years since then, 133 Scholarship grants have been awarded to 106 individual students.

To the student who will be a junior or senior in the Fall of 2024 and who has a grade point average of 2.75 of 4.0 or better, we invite you to consider applying for this scholarship. You will give our congregation the opportunity to help you in your college endeavor. It will give you the opportunity to receive a grant of at least \$ 1,000 toward your scholastic expenses. Recent grants have been more generous. Request an application form from the First United Methodist Church office by calling (818) 340-2950. Complete the application and return it to the church office not later than Thursday, February 15, 2024 for consideration.

For people who would like to support the Laura Longman Memorial Scholarship, contributions may be made in memory of Laura Longman, or in memory or honor of your family member or friend. Please make your check payable to the First United Methodist Church with a memo designating the Laura Longman Memorial Scholarship fund. If appropriate, attach a note that this contribution is in memory or honor of [your special person]. Your donation may be tax deductible. One hundred percent of your donation will be invested in scholarship benefits for students. We thank you in advance for your participation.
